



School Instructions and Rules for the Scholastic year 2020-2021

Dear Parents,

Please, read and comply with our school instructions and rules for the academic year 2020-2021. These instructions and rules have been designed and implemented to guarantee students safety first and to ensure a successful and prosper scholastic year.

Rule 1: Morning Attendance

The first class starts at 8:00 a.m., as usual, and the morning assembly time will be inside the classes with the presence of the homeroom teachers. The national anthem will be performed and the Fatihah will be recited daily by the students inside the classes with the supervision of the teachers; this is due to the current situation we are going through.

Rule 2: School Transportation Rounds Schedule

The end of the school hours and departure will be on two rounds:

- The first round will be at 12:00 p.m.
- The second round will be at 1:30 p.m.

This is due to reducing the class time to 40 minutes per class and reducing the break time to 10-minutes, according to the instructions of the Ministry of Education.

From Tuesday 01/09/2020 until Thursday 03/09/2020, the first round will be at 11:15 a.m. and the second round will stay as it is at 1:30 p.m.

- K.G Grades, Learning Resources Section, and 1-3 National and International Sections will depart in the first round.
- Grades (4-9), national and international, will depart in the second round, other grades' departure depends on students' daily schedule last period timing.

Rule 3: Parents are required to:

- Obtain a pre- approval appointment prior to their school visit.
- Parents are prohibited to enter classrooms.
- Parents are prohibited to be present at school bus yards regardless the circumstance.



- Parents have to emphasize on children the necessity of wearing masks and gloves when leaving the house and when entering the bus or school. No student will be allowed to enter school without wearing masks.
- Please do not bring your child to school with symptoms of cold, flu, and high fever.
- Guide your child to:
 - Adhere to the instructions of teachers and principals regarding the process of social distancing.
 - Bring private school supplies and not to use others' tools.
 - Carry out the sterilization process, according to the instructions of the homeroom teachers and counselors, and using the sterilization tools available in all school departments.
- Cell phones are prohibited at school premises.
- Parents are required to read, comprehend and comply with Jordan Ministry of Education student disciplinary rules and regulations. Explain and ensure student commitment.
- Parents are required to attend school parent-teacher annual meetings. These meetings are essential to guarantee students success.
