***** Attendance Policy



Definitions:

- A. Absence from School: A student is absent from school when he/she is not physically present.
- B. Excused Absence: A student is absent when he/she is not present during an entire regularly scheduled attendance period according to the following conditions:
 - A note or phone call from the parent/guardian.
 - A pass from a staff member (Social Worker).
 - A statement from the doctor, a copy of documents from court appearances.
 - Another form of legitimate documentation explaining the absence.
- C. **Unexcused Absence**: All absences are considered unexcused unless the student has a note or phone call from the parent/guardian, a pass from a staff member (Social Worker), a statement from the doctor, a copy of documents from court appearances, or another form of legitimate documentation explaining the absence.
 - ✓ The absentees will be marked as A in the attendance file, soft copy will be sent to the IT department and the administration department to document the absence
 - ✓ The school follows the Ministry of Education laws for absence.
