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Educational Counseling

Introduction:

It is our duty to provide students with the best educational counseling service which can lead for better future. Therefore, our job is fully aligned with school vision and mission.

Our job duties, tasks and responsibilities are summarized as follow:

1) Counsel students regarding educational issues such as course and program selections (British & American), school adjustment, study habits, and career planning.

2) Counsel individuals to help them understand and overcome personal and social problems affecting their educational. It is preferred to draft an Individual study plan.

3) Maintain accurate and complete student records as required by the ministry of education regulations. Behavior, teachers' notes and academic reports are documented and located at head of department office, upon requested.

4) Discuss with parents or guardians, teachers, previous school counselors, and administrators to resolve students' academic issues.

5) Provide educational alternative plans when difficult situations occur.

6) Meet with parents and guardians to discuss individual (Student) progress, and to provide academic program solution(s), options and choices according to each student needs and expectations.

7) Counsel students regarding requirements needed to attend local and abroad universities.

8) Provide educational assistance regarding applying to colleges and universities, such as unified admission unit and Common Application websites. Teachers and counselor recommendation letters are available upon requested.

9) Provide students and parents with the latest updated information from Jordanian Ministry of Education and Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research regarding the Jordanian high school equivalency rules, regulations and procedures which are essential to attend local universities.
